

PARK Rules for Halecrest Park, Inc.

These rules are set forth by the Halecrest Board of Directors to ensure a safe and enjoyable experience by all individuals visiting Halecrest Park, Inc.

It is the responsibility of each family to educate their entire household of the following Park and Pool rules.

Park Hours: 7am – 10pm

1. **ALL GATES MUST REMAIN CLOSED AT ALL TIMES** (*Propping the gates open will not be tolerated*); this is also a requirement of the Health Department.
2. Children under the age of 7 **MUST** be supervised by an adult when using the park and restrooms.
3. **ALL** children must be supervised when using the playground or when near high activity areas, such as the horseshoe pits, tennis courts, and volleyball courts.
4. Tennis courts, volleyball courts, horseshoe pits, play equipment, barbeques, fire rings, and picnic tables are to be used on a “first-come, first-serve basis”; however, sharing with other members and guests is encouraged.
5. Bikes, skateboards, rollerblades, and similar equipment are **NOT** to be used in the park. Bikes must be parked in the bike racks.
6. Foul and offensive language, loud music, and excessive noise, will **NOT** be tolerated.
7. Smoking in restrooms, clubhouses, on pool deck, or tennis courts is prohibited.
8. Only tennis shoes are to be worn on the tennis courts.
9. The fire rings can be used by anyone 18 years or older – (Only wood burning allowed).
10. You are responsible for keeping your area clean, and for picking up your trash. Please empty any filled trash cans into the outside dumpsters, and insert a new liner.
11. **NO** pets allowed, at any time.
12. **NO** tree climbing permitted.
13. Halecrest Park is not responsible for any lost or stolen items.
14. As a member, you will be held accountable and responsible for the actions of your guests.
15. Climbing of the walls and fences is prohibited at all times.

POSSESSION OF AND/OR USE OF ILLEGAL DRUGS IS STRICLY PROHIBITED!

GUEST POLICY

1. Each member may bring in **ONE** pool guest, per day, at no charge. There will be a \$2.00 charge for each additional pool guest, payable upon entry. (Guests residing 50 miles or more from Halecrest may be admitted free).
2. Terminated/resigned club members shall not be allowed as a park guest for two years.
3. **PRIVATE PARTIES OF 10 OR MORE, BUT NOT TO EXCEED 25, MUST BE HELD IN THE LARGE PARK. YOU MUST ALSO NOTIFY THE PARK OFFICE AT LEAST 48 HOURS PRIOR TO THE EVENT!**
4. The park & pools are only for members in good standing to use.

Any of the above infractions will be subject to disciplinary actions by a lifeguard, Halecrest employee, and/or a Board of Director. Frequent or continued disregard for the “PARK AND POOL RULES,” will result in expulsion of the premises and/or cancellation of membership to Halecrest Park, Inc.

Members and their guests using Halecrest Park, Inc. facilities agree to abide by all **PARK AND POOL RULES**, policies and regulations. Furthermore, all users agree to follow instructions from Halecrest Staff and Personnel. Members will also acknowledge that MEMBERSHIP DUES MUST BE CURRENT in order to use the Halecrest Park facilities. By signing below we have read and agree to these terms.

POOL RULES FOR HALECREST PARK, INC.

Pool Hours:

Summer (April – October): 7am – 10pm / Winter (November – March): 7am – 8pm

Lap Swim Hours (age 16 and older): Monday – Friday 7am – 8am and 6pm – 7pm

LIFEGUARD ON DUTY: When a lifeguard is on duty, all children 7 years old and younger must be accompanied by someone 16 years or older, who is able to swim the length of the pool as instructed by the lifeguard.

NO LIFEGUARD ON DUTY: When a lifeguard is not on duty, all children ages 14 and younger will **NOT** be allowed in the pool area unless accompanied by someone 18 years or older, who can swim the length of the pool. It is recommended that this person possess CPR and life saving training.

ALL GATES MUST REMAIN CLOSED AT ALL TIMES! Do not prop gates!

1. Proper swim attire is required at all times. **No street clothes will be permitted.**
2. No infants or individuals not “potty trained” will be allowed in the pool without “swim diapers”.
3. No changing of diapers, etc. on or around the pool deck. This must be done in the restrooms.
4. No food, gum, or glass containers allowed around or in the pool or restrooms.
5. Eating is permitted in all grass areas adjacent the pool, please keep your area clean and dispose of trash properly. No Food is permitted on the pool deck.
6. No smoking permitted on the pool deck.
7. The planters are not to be used as ashtrays or for litter.
8. Shower in the restroom before entering the pools.
9. Long hair is to be secured into a ponytail. All metal clips must be removed.
10. Any person with open sores or bandages will not be allowed in the pool.
11. An adult must supervise children under the age of 7 to the restroom.
12. Adult members have first priority on pool lounges at all times.
13. Foul and offensive language, loud music, and excessive noise, will **NOT** be tolerated.
14. Bikes, skateboards, rollerblades, and similar equipment are **NOT** are allowed on the pool deck.

The following items ARE permitted in the pool: diving masks and small kicks boards are permitted.

Children under the age of 7 with adult supervision may use: small rings, water wings, and floating devices.

The following items ARE NOT permitted in the pool: (Lifeguard on duty will determine what is acceptable.)

Styrofoam, metal, pointed or hard objects, playground balls, hard balls, tennis balls, etc., rafts, boogie boards, inner tubes, floating devices larger than swim rings, swim fins or diving equipment.

Rules regarding the diving board:

Only one person at a time permitted on the diving board. Dive only when safe to do so. No hanging on or staying under the diving board. Stay out of the red painted area surrounding the diving board. Diving or jumping is permitted straight off the end of the board *only*. No running on the board. Floating devices are not permitted while diving or jumping off the board.

ACTIVITIES NOT PERMITTED IN OR AROUND THE POOLS:

No excessive splashing, dunking, or foul play. No running, pushing, chicken fighting, back dives, or flips from the sides of the pool. No jumping off people’s shoulders or throwing objects of any kind. Foul and offensive language will **NOT** be tolerated.

***NO ONE LESS THAN 18 YEARS OF AGE WILL BE ALLOWED IN THE POOL OR PARK
AFTER DUSK UNLESS ACCOMPANIED BY A PARENT!***
